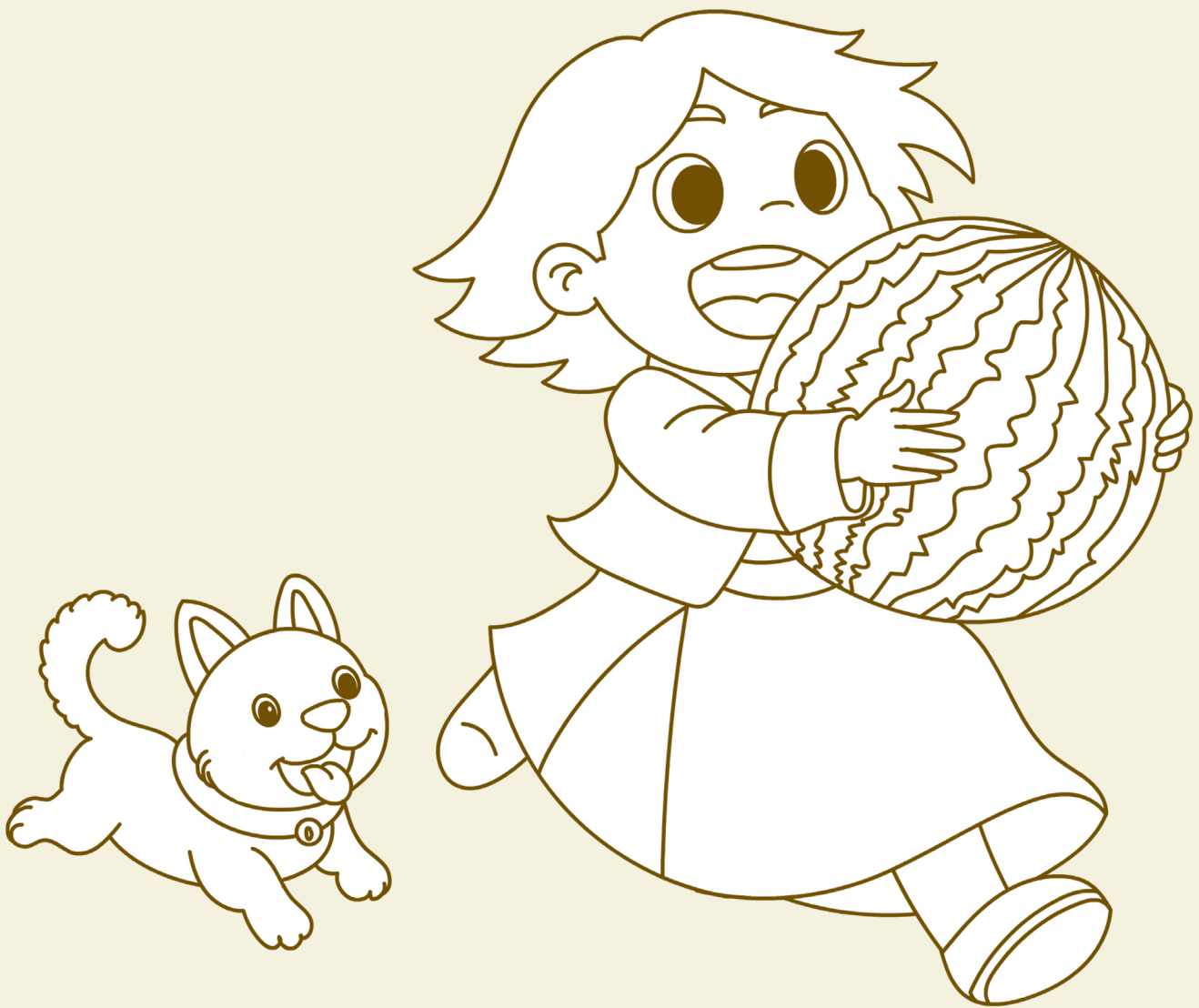

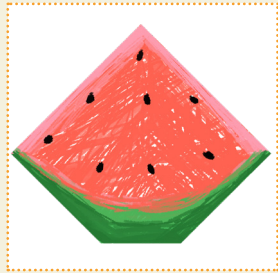

These are the things you will need :

1. Square Paper
2. Colours ( Red, green and black)

**1** Fold the square paper into half along the dotted lines.



**2** Fold the front top corner downward along the dotted lines.



**3** Fold the right corner upward along the dotted lines and tug it inside. Repeat the step for left side.



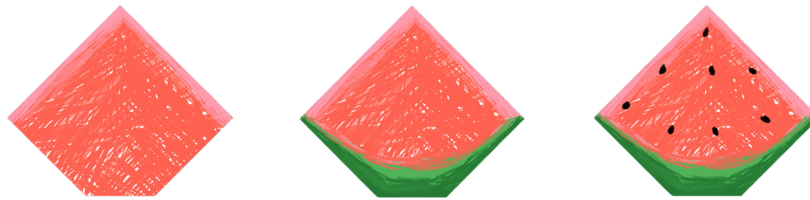
**4** Fold the top corner downward along the dotted lines and flip the paper backward..

**5** Colour everything red and colour the bottom side green.  
Then draw black dots for seed.



Tug it in the corner of your book pages and use it as bookmark.
